



Why Did Jesus Have to Rise from the Dead?

"... Paul shows that everything stands or falls with Christ's bodily resurrection" (Henry Thiessen, Lectures in Systematic Theology, pp. 89-90).



1 Corinthians 15:12-19



If Jesus did not Rise:

- He was a liar (Matt. 20:19; 28:6).
- We would have no one to intercede for us or enable us.
- There is no Gospel (i.e., Good News)!
- Believers are fools!



Why Did Jesus
Have to Rise
from the Dead?

We took a deeper dive





First, Jesus Did Die:

Proof of John 19:34, "But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out" (NASB).



Second, the empty tomb witnesses to Jesus' resurrection:

The apostle John gives his testimony of how he believed in the resurrection by considering the evidence of the empty tomb in John 20:3-9.



Third, the New Testament includes eye witness accounts of Jesus' appearances after His resurrection:

- Mary Magdalene and other women
 (Mt 28:8-10; Mk 16:9-10; Jn 20:11-18)
- **Peter** (Luke 24:34; 1 Cor 15:5)
- Disciples on the road to Emmaus (Mark 16:12; Luke 24:13-32)
- Disciples in the Upper Room (Luke 24:36-43; John 20:19-25)
- Disciples the next Sunday (Mk 16:14; Jn 20:26-29)
- 7 disciples by the Sea of Galilee (Jn 21:1-24)
- **More than 500 brethren** (1 Cor 15:6-7)



Fourth, the New Testament records that Jesus' resurrected body is a physical body:

- Recognizable (John 20:20)
- Crucifixion wounds still present (John 20:25-29; Rev 5:6)
- Ate food even though He did not need to eat (Luke 24:30-33, 41-43)
- Is not just a spirit because His body has flesh and bones (Luke 24:39-40)
- But Jesus' resurrection body allows Him to enter rooms without opening doors (Luke 24:36; John 20:19)



KEYCONCEPT

If Jesus did not rise from the dead, we have no hope. Our lives are wasted. There is no Gospel. We are fools.



Based on the historical record of events provided by the Bible, it is reasonable to believe that Jesus did indeed die and rise from the dead.

Jesus' Resurrection:


- Proves that He is God
- Proves that He is the Messiah
- Ensures our new birth (i.e., our regeneration)
- Ensures that the power that raised Jesus from the dead is the same power working in us
- Empowers believers to experience victory over sin
- Ensures our right relationship with God (i.e., our justification)
- Guarantees the resurrection of believers



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


My friend told me this when I explained the Gospel:

What if God has revealed who He is and I keep pushing Him away?




Romans 1:19-20,



Jesus demonstrated human characteristics


- He was hungry (Matthew 4:2)

FOUNDATIONAL BLOCKS



Every person is born a sinner (each have a bent toward sin – i.e., a sin nature), but every person also commits acts of sin.



Romans 3:23,
"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (NASB).



Romans 6:23a,

"For the wages of sin is death..." (NASB).

Romans 6:23a,

"For the payoff of sin is death..." (NLT).





People are born sinners and people commit acts of sin. God declares that the penalty for sin is death, physical and spiritual.

God's Holiness = God is completely separate from sin.

He cannot be in relationship with sinful people.



God's Righteousness = God is right and just. He is the standard of rightness!





God's holiness and righteousness demands that sin be punished if people are to ever be in right relationship with Him.

Why Jesus?





"Christ the sinless One took on Himself the penalty that should have been borne by man. . . (Charles Ryrie, <u>Basic Theology</u>, p. 309).



Romans 5:6-8,

"For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (NASB).



Romans 5:9-10,

"Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him. For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life" (NASB).



1 Peter 3:18,

"For Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit" (NASB).



2 Corinthians 5:21, "He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him" (NASB).





God's holiness and righteousness demands that sin be punished if people are to ever be in right relationship with Him.



Matthew 7:13-14,

"You can enter God's Kingdom only through the narrow gate. The highway to hell is broad, and its gate is wide for many who choose that way. But the gateway to life is very narrow and the road is difficult, and only a few ever find it" (NLT).



John 14:6,

"Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me" (NASB).



1 Timothy 2:5,

"For there is only one God and one Mediator who can reconcile God and people. He is the man Christ Jesus" (NLT).



1 John 5:11-13,

"And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life. These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life" (NASB).




