




Inspired - even when using human authors, ultimately authored by God Himself; the very word of God

Inerrant - without error or mistakes in the original documents; completely true

Infallible - incapable of error; completely reliable and trustworthy and will never not be so

Authoritative - the inherent right and power to speak as the very word of God



Psalm 119:111 - Your testimonies are my heritage forever, for they are the joy of my heart.

Psalm 119:89 - Forever, O Lord, your word is firmly fixed in the heavens.

Isaiah 40:8 - The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever.

Matthew 24:35 - Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

John 10:35 - ...Scripture cannot be broken...



"For belief, we have a true, unchanging super food; Scripture. God's Word is a revelation of him, and to consume it is to fill yourself with what he wants you to know of him. Those of us who grew up in the church have been told all our lives sometimes so often that it can become burdensome and like homework - to 'read your Bible everyday.' That's why it's important to realize that we don't merely read our Bibles, we consume them. God's Word is sustenance to our souls, not merely suggestions or lessons or words of instruction. We need it to live. If we fill our souls with other things, it's similar to living on a diet of cotton candy. It might taste delicious at first, but after a while we get tired of it and feel ill. If it were all we ate, we would waste away because it has no nutritional value. Scripture is the nutrition our souls need, a regular multicourse dinner of it."




